### 1. Who is the data controller? What are the cookies?

1.1 As regards the necessary and own cookies used on this website the data controller is **Oppenheim Law Firm** (seat: 1053 Budapest, Károlyi utca 12.; e-mail: office@oppenheimlegal.com; hereinafter: **Contoller** or **Oppenheim**).

1.2 The cookie is a small text file, which is stored on your computer or mobile device. We use cookies strictly necessary for technical purposes, and to enable you to use the website. This may be used later on to customize the website based on the user's choice and interests. A common type of cookie is the „session cookie”.

1.3. You can restrict or block cookies by changing browser or mobile device settings. You can also delete previously stored cookies through your browser. Further information can be found on the support pages of your browser or mobile device. Please note that certain features and functions of the website require cookies and may not operate properly if cookies are deleted or rejected.

### 2. Cookies used on this website and legal bases

The necessary cookies used on our website are stored without your consent, while other cookies are stored on your device only with your consent.

#### (A) NECESSARY COOKIES

Cookies or settings strictly necessary for the operation of the website: without essential cookies the website will not operate at all or as intended, and these cookies are necessary to run the website or to save settings you have made on the website. These cookies may only apply to operations such as language, text size and privacy preferences. These cookies cannot be disabled, and they are usually set based on your permission on the website. If you block these cookies as a user, the website will not operate properly. We use necessary cookies in line with Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, and Section 13/A(3) of Act CVIII of 2001 on electronic commerce, in order to provide service.

#### (B) PERFORMACE COOKIES

We do not use such cookies.

#### (C) STATISTICS COOKIES (based on your consent)

Statistical cookies collect information about how visitors use our website. These cookies cannot exactly identify the users. The information collected by statistical cookies includes page views, clicks, session length, time of visit, etc. These cookies are activated by us or by the third party providing the specific functionality if

you choose to use that functionality. You may choose not to allow the use of these cookies and you may change your cookie settings any time (see point 3).

__utma	Used to distinguish users and sessions. The cookie is created when the javascript library executes and no existing __utma cookies exists. The cookie is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.	2 years
__utmb	Used to determine new sessions/visits. The cookie is created when the javascript library executes and no existing __utmb cookies exists. The cookie is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.	30 minutes
__utmc	Not used in ga.js. Set for interoperability with urchin.js. Historically, this cookie operated in conjunction with the __utmb cookie to determine whether the user was in a new session/visit.	Session
__utmt	Used to throttle request rate.	10 minutes
__utmz	Stores the traffic source or campaign that explains how the user reached your site. The cookie is created when the javascript library executes and is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.	6 months
